 - Chief Hare explained some of things that he thinks council should change regarding the firework ordinance. Some of the things mentioned were shorting the dates and times of when people can shoot fireworks.
- 2nd Business/City Meet and Greet Scheduled for August
 - O Mayor Brosious mentioned that sometime in August he plans to have a meet and greet with businesses to help with the marketing of their business. Mayor Brosious mentioned some of the speakers that he has lined up already are Alex Rissinger, and Tom Webb to give information that will be helpful to the businesses in Sunbury.
- DCED Façade Grant
 - o Mayor Brosious mentioned that he sent the City Administrator a grant that could possibly help the downtown businesses.
- SRI Chestnut Street Property (Parcel No. 049-01-004-066)
 - o Councilman Eister mentioned that SRI would like to give the property back to the City.
- South Front Retaining Wall
 - Steve Welker explained the concerns that PennDot is having on the South Front Retaining Wall, and is hoping that the City and other officials write a letter of support to PennDot.
- Find My iPhone Policy

- Council Eister explained why he thinks each city iPhone should have Find My iPhone enabled. Council and City officials discussed the possible concerns with having Find My iPhone enabled.
- Handheld Parking Meter Devices
 - O Chief Hare explained that the current handheld parking meter devices will be running out of service on Dec. 31st and thinks that council should only purchase two instead of three. Council discussed the possible funding options for the handled meters. Council and City Officials also discussed the options that they have regarding parking meters.
